- A Literacy Assessment
- All Career Life Connections requirements for Grade 11 & 12 (4 credits total) including:
 - Attending all CLC sessions and completing all assignments
 - A Capstone Project and Presentation in Grade 12
 - 30 Hours of Experiential Learning (Work Experience)
- One Fine Art (FNA) OR Applied Design Skills & Technologies (ADST) course at the grade 10, 11 or 12 level
- One Indigenous-focussed course at the grade 10, 11, or 12 level.
