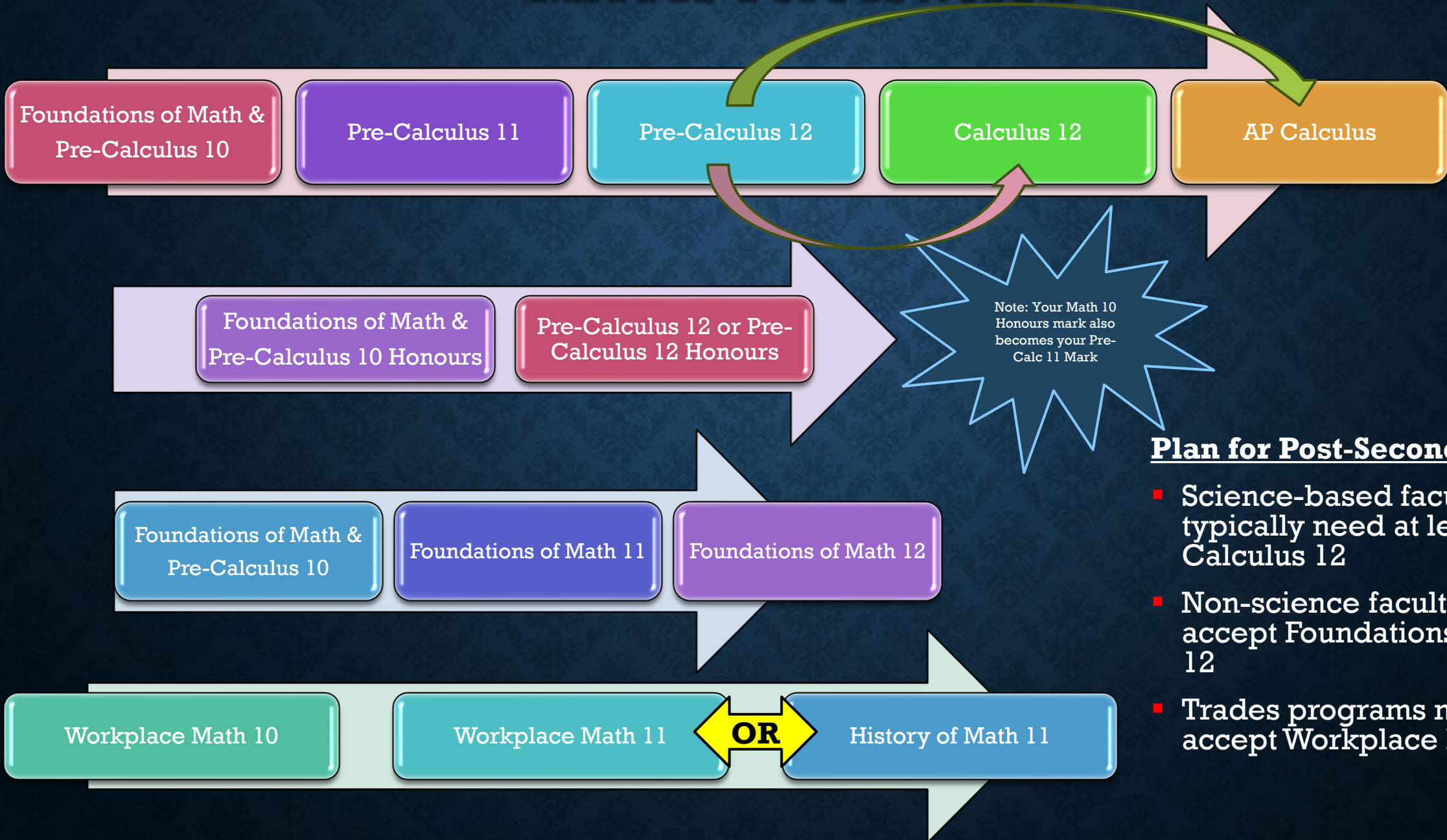

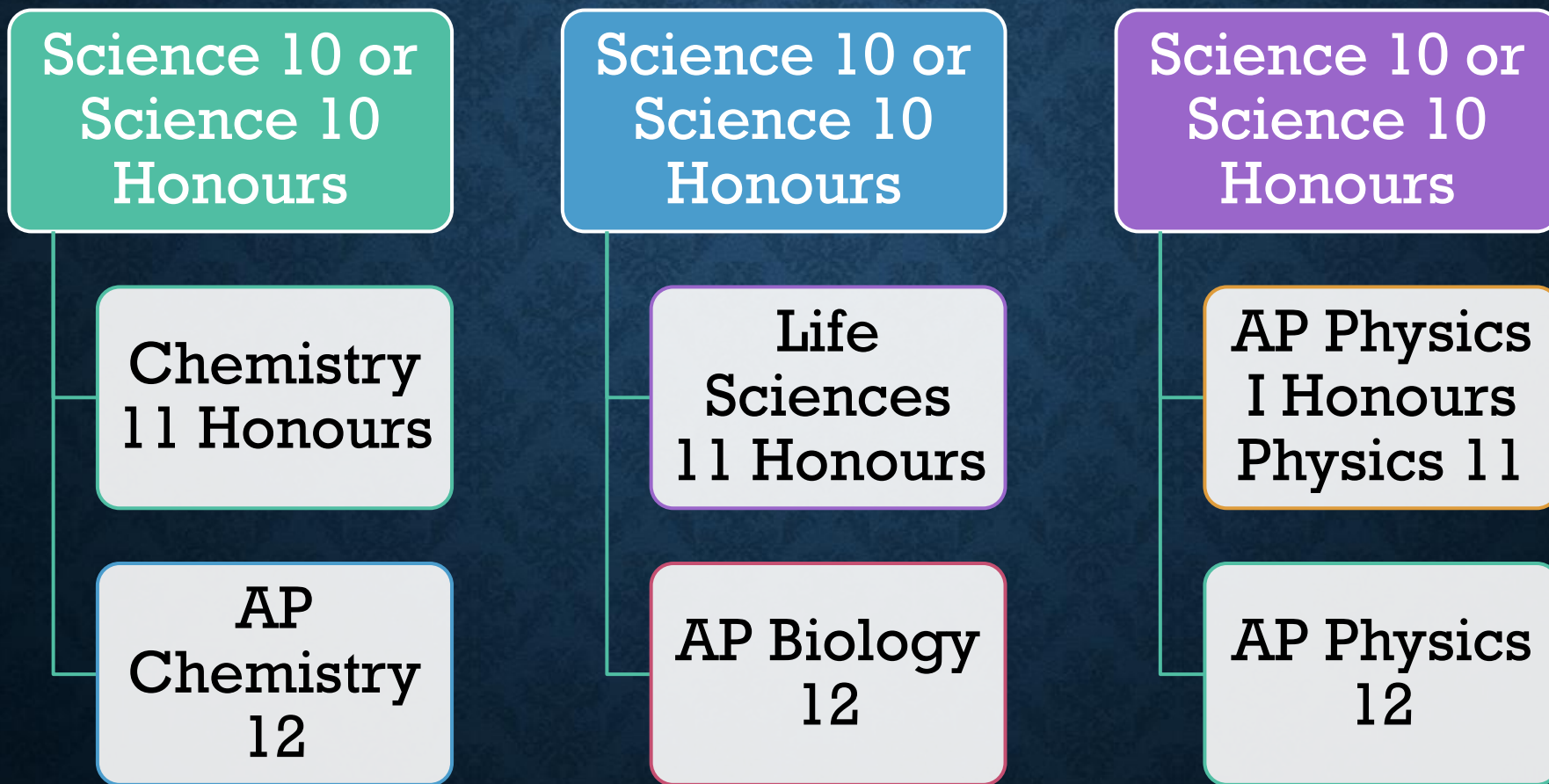
MATH PATHWAYS



Plan for Post-Secondary:

- Science-based faculties typically need at least Pre-Calculus 12
- Non-science faculties often accept Foundations of Math 12
- Trades programs may accept Workplace Math 11

LANGUAGE COURSES



New! Universities no longer require a second language for admission



Language courses are electives, but considered academic by universities.



If you did not take a Language in Grade 8, 9 or 10 you can still take an Introductory Language class in Grade 11 or 12.



ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP)

- **AP Courses offer:**
- access to rigorous university-level work
- exploration of subjects at a deeper level of learning
- advancement of research and communication skills
- 4 credits per course towards graduation requirements
- possible credit for first-year university courses if you do well enough on the AP Exam (in May)
