



2026 Moscrop Safe After Grad Party – Frequently Asked Questions



The Moscrop Safe After Grad Party Committee has prepared some answers to common questions regarding this event for your information. Please note some event details may be subject to change.

1. What is the purpose of Safe After Grad?

This parent-run event provides graduates with a fun, safe, supervised, and substance-free way to continue celebrating after their formal graduation dinner/dance party.

2. Where and when does the event take place? What time does it start and end?

Date: Friday, June 12, 2026

Location: The Rec Room Brentwood (1920 Willingdon Ave, Burnaby - Brentwood Mall)

Event Time: 11:30 PM – 2:30 AM

This is a closed event, no ins and outs; students are expected to remain for the duration.

3. What is the theme and dress code?

Theme: Casino Royale

Students are welcome to participate in the theme, but it is not required. Private change areas will be available for students wishing to change into more comfortable clothing.

Attire must be respectful and appropriate for a supervised graduation event.



Please bring appropriate footwear - the venue does not permit bare feet.

4. Where can I store my belongings?

A secure, monitored storage room will be available and supervised by adult chaperones. Students are strongly encouraged to leave valuables at home. The venue and committee are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

5. Is there a registration / check-in process?

- Students will undergo a security & bag check before boarding chartered buses at the Pan Pacific
- Students will be escorted into The Rec Room by security and adult chaperones
- A second security and bag check will take place inside The Rec Room
- Game bands and prize draw entries will be provided upon entry



6. What entertainment is included?

Entertainment highlights include – Access to the arcades, pool table, ping pong table, karaoke, DJ & dance floor, photo booth, door prizes, swag bags for all attendees & more!





7. Can I bring my own Rec Room Game Band or buy more game credits?

Each ticket includes a 367-credit game band. Students may bring personal game bands if they wish. The prize redemption store will be open. The committee and venue are not responsible for lost or stolen bands or prizes.



8. How do I get to the event?

Students will only be permitted entry to the Safe After Grad Event via pre-arranged chartered buses (Lynch Bus Lines) which will transport grads from the Moscrop Grad Dinner/Dance at the Pan Pacific to The Rec Room. Boarding will begin around 11:00 PM. Instructions will announced during the dinner/dance. Students must follow these directions to ensure they do not miss the bus. Event entry will not be permitted otherwise.

9. How do students get home?

Chartered buses will depart The Rec Room at 2:30 AM to return students to the Moscrop Parking Lot arriving at approximately 2:45 AM. There will be no pick-ups at The Rec Room.

To align with the purpose of our event, parents/guardians are responsible for ensuring your child has a safe ride home upon arrival at the Moscrop parking lot. Walking home at that time is discouraged.



10. Who can attend?

This event is only accessible to current Grade 12 Moscrop students attending the formal Moscrop Grad Dinner/Dance on June 12 who have a valid ticket to attend the Safe After Grad Party. Outside guests are not permitted.



11. Are ins and outs allowed? What if I need to leave early?

Due to the purpose of this event, attendees must remain inside the venue until the event is over. Early pick-up from The Rec Room is not permitted.

12. Will food and beverages will be provided? What about dietary restrictions?

Complimentary food and non-alcoholic beverages will be available. Dietary restrictions can be noted during ticket purchase or emailed to moscropsafegrad2026@gmail.com

13. Will there be security?

The Rec Room will provide 2 (two) security guards and approximately 20 staff members to support our event needs. Parent/guardian chaperones will also be onsite during the event.

14. What other health & safety measures are in place?

- First Aid attendant on site
- Attendance checked against the guest list when boarding and exiting buses
- Monitored security cameras at the venue



Zero-Tolerance Policy

This event follows a **zero-tolerance policy**. Any student who violates these rules will be removed, and a parent/guardian will be contacted for immediate pick-up.



- No smoking, vaping, alcohol, or drug use
- No possession of alcohol, narcotics, weapons, or prohibited items
- No disrespectful behavior, harassment, violence, or sexual misconduct
- Students must follow the school's Code of Conduct and all staff/chaperone instructions

15. What does my ticket include?

Your event ticket includes a 367-credit Rec Room game band, access to all arcades and entertainment, food & beverages, prize draw entries and a complimentary grad swag bag.



16. How do I purchase tickets?

Tickets can be purchased through School Cash Online. Limited in-person opportunities (cash or tap) will be announced via school bulletins and the Grad Teams channel.

17. What if I can no longer attend? Are there any refunds?

Tickets are non-refundable due to pre-paid deposits. If you can no longer attend, notify us at moscropsafegrad2026@gmail.com.
