2. Principal's Report – Paul Fester	 The Burnaby school website and email addresses for faculty have changed. Operating systems are changing from Windows 7 to Windows 10 in this summer. There will be 179 computers replaced. Preliminary numbers for September 2018 show 50 more Grade 8s in our catchment area and should have about 330 Grade 8s attending in the fall. We are also estimated to have 82 French Immersion students joining in the fall 2018. We have about 270 Grade 12s this year and foresee some challenges with increased enrollment. Moscrop is considered a "Bee" school and we are going to try using Sugar Cane paper instead of recycled paper (the cost is relatively the same or less than recycled paper). After June, there will be an option to buy sugar cane paper.
