Protocols

*While this school year will be closer to a normal year we will still be following many Health & Safety Protocols under the guidance of public health authorities and the Ministry of Education. Some of these protocols are as follows:

- All students must complete a Daily Health Check at home, sanitize/wash hands upon entering the building and students must use the entrance that is closest to their 1st period class.
- Students who are ill (cold, flu or showing COVID-19 symptoms) must stay home. If a student becomes ill during the school day parents will be contacted to come and pick them up as soon as possible.
- All students must wear a mask while inside the building.
- Students are encouraged not to gather while inside the building and to maintain physical distance.
- Cafeteria service will be available Wednesday, September 8th. Students should eat outside whenever possible. Students must not share food.
- Visitors to the school building will continue to be discouraged and any visitors must continue to sign in at the main office and wear a non-medical mask when inside the building. Parents are asked to book an appointment or reach out to school staff by phone, virtual meeting or email.
