2.) Principal Report:

- a. Quarter 1 has been completed and Quarter 2 will be starting on November 18, 2020
- b. Covid there has been an exposure. There has been no transmissions at the school. Safety protocols has been in place.
- c. Lunch As the school enters the winter months, the school is encouraging students to have their lunch in their period 1 class.
- d. Contingency plan has been in place in case of Covid out-breaks including switching to virtual learning platform using Microsoft teams.
- e. Construction City pedestrian control on Moscrop and Baker Street is in progress. A change in traffic configuration and traffic flow will include entrance only on Moscrop Street. Estimated completion date will be by January 2021.
- f. School clubs are being held during this school year but on a virtual basis.
- g. Newly installed sinks have been put in place throughout the school to help minimize any risk. Cost of the sinks was funded by the school district.

- a. For the year ended July 31, 2020, The PAC received gaming revenue of \$27,940. Total expenditures related to school expenses and scholarships totaled \$23,111.31 for the year.
- b. Cash balance at July 31, 2020: Gaming account \$21,708.25 and current PAC current account of \$3,315.94
- c. On October 14, 2020, the PAC received \$27,580.00 of PAC Gaming revenue for the 2020/2021 school year.
- d. Cash balance as of November 16, 2020 Gaming account \$49,288.25 and PAC current account of \$3,315.94

5.) PAC Funding:

- a. The PAC has continued to support the school's initiatives each year. Mr. Fester, has submitted the 2020/2021 school's budget request for PAC.
