We are hopeful for a safe return to in-person gatherings. BCYP will follow all Provincial Public Health Guidelines including a requirement that **all participants be fully vaccinated against COVID-19.**

- The Youth Parliament is a province-wide non-partisan organization for young people ages 16 to 21. It teaches citizenship skills through participation in the parliamentary session in December and continuing involvement in community service activities throughout the year. **Youth Parliament is a one-year commitment.** As the Youth Parliament is non-partisan, applicants need only be interested in learning more about the parliamentary process and in serving their community upon return from their time in Victoria.
