**GRADE 12 STUDENTS INTERESTED IN TRADES: ARE YOU CONSIDERING WORKING FULL-TIME AFTER HIGHSCHOOL?**

Ms. Wispinski, Career Education Advisor, is the District Specialist in Trades and would like to talk with you. We have a few trades / employers who are looking for youth (male / female) who are interested in working in a hands-on trade directly after high school. They will train on the job and ensure any training you need is arranged. These are companies that focus on working safely, and are looking to train youth into high demand careers.

- Company who helps maintain large industrial buildings, needs various individuals interested in construction trades: carpentry, plumbing, steam fitting, electrical
- Iron workers – must be able to lift 50 pounds and be comfortable working at heights
- Mechanical Insulators – insulating pipes, boilers, air condition units etc – be comfortable with working in some small spaces
- Radio tower installer – must be comfortable with working at heights
- Carpentry-Youth Train in Trades – get your foundation training in Carpentry paid for by Burnaby School District, you pay for your own safety gear, and textbook, and hand tools, we pay for the tuition. Huge demand for carpenters. **Grade 12 students graduating in June are eligible to take a 6<sup>th</sup> . Year of studies in any of our programs delivered in Burnaby Schools.**

Youth Apprenticeship Program – Burnaby Students up to the age of 19 can contact Ms. Wispinski – and if they are working in a TRADE, get signed as a Youth Apprenticeship and qualify for Ministry of Education Youth Apprenticeship Award of \$1000. This program has been created as an incentive to get youth to enter into trades, as they are in high demand – and lead to excellent career pathways.
