



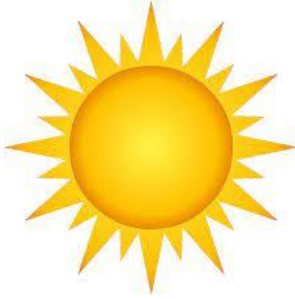

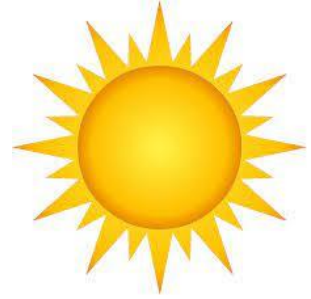

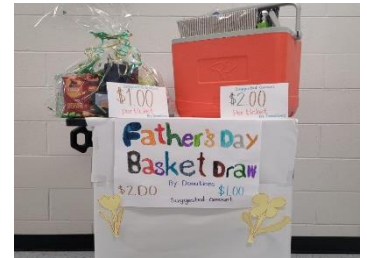
SPORTS BANQUET
