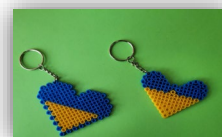

**Congratulations to Sofia Li for being awarded as the Athlete of the Month for March!!**

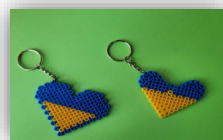
