The program focus areas are Community Development, Health & Wellness, STEM, Personal Development and Mentorship. This year, the in-person summit will **take place July 6<sup>th</sup>- July 8<sup>th</sup>** and **applications will open on Monday, May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023**.

We have added an internship component to the program inviting EBG participants to explore and gain experience in their career fields of interest over four months. The internship component is an addition we are incredibly excited about as we know that students who have internship experiences in high school have benefits beyond developing professional aptitude but providing them with the opportunity for career exploration and encouraging the development of new skills.

We will not tolerate negativity or rule breaking. I would like to ask everyone to take a moment to review some important rules. Failure to follow election rules can result in candidate disqualification. The student body can expect to hear candidate speeches on April 13th in the large gym and Grade Rep speeches in classrooms. #### **Campaign Rules:**

- **Candidate SPEECHES on election day is the ONLY promoting permitted**
- **Poster advertising, t-shirts, pins, etc. are NOT allowed (e.g. candidates may NOT wear voting t-shirts or pins, post on social media, or make announcements, etc.)**
- **Campaigning on social media is NOT allowed**

- Endorsement by student peers and Teachers is NOT allowed (e.g., student peers and Teachers may NOT wear candidate voting t-shirts or pins, post on social media, or make announcements, etc.)
- Bribing peers for votes is NOT allowed (e.g., food handouts, money, etc.)


