CLUBS CREATION:

Hey Panthers! Are you interested in starting your own club? Here is how you can get started:

1. Check the Master Club List

Before starting your club, visit the Master Club List on the Moscrop website ([Link here](#)) to review existing clubs. Since our school already has many, we want to avoid duplicate clubs with similar purposes.

2. Develop Your Club Idea

Clearly define your club's objective, purpose, and goals. This will help guide your club's activities and distinguish it from others.

3. Find a Sponsor Teacher

Your sponsor teacher will play an important role in overseeing your club and ensuring the well-being of your members. They must be present (or in school) during all meetings (especially when they are happening before or after school) to maintain a safe environment.

4. Book a Caucus Meeting

Head to the office to schedule a caucus meeting, where you'll propose your club. You'll need to complete a form detailing your club's objectives and your sponsor teacher.

5. Attend the Caucus Meeting

Present your club idea to the Principal and Vice Principals during the meeting. (Don't worry, they are SUPER DUPER nice!) If they find your proposal appropriate, they will approve your club's creation.

6. Start Hosting Meetings & Events

Once your club is approved through caucus, you're all set to begin organizing meetings and hosting events!
